Paints – Watercolor

You can use tubes or color blocks. These are your primary and secondary colors plus black, white, burnt umber and yellow ochre

Cadmium Red – medium
Cadmium Orange – medium
Cadmium Yellow – medium
Permanent Green – light
Cerulean Blue (Chromium)

Yellow Ochre or Yellow Oxide
Prism Violet
Burnt Umber
Ultramarine Blue
Titanium White

- 2" Flat
- 1" Flat
- 1/2" Flat
- 1 or 2 Round, any size

Surfaces – 140 or 300lb watercolor paper any size
